

**MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR
NO. 03-74**

SUBJECT: REQUIRING ALL APPLICATIONS FOR LICENSES FOR BROADCAST AND TELEVISION STATIONS INCLUDING TV TRANSLATOR STATIONS, AND FOR PUBLIC FIXED POINT-TO-POINT AND PUBLIC COASTAL STATION TO BE SUPPORTED BY CERTIFICATES OF PUBLIC CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY/AUTHORITY TO CHARGE RATES.

In accordance with Memorandum Circular No. 74-04 dated June 04, 1974 issued by the Board of Communications pursuant to the provisions of Commonwealth Act No. 146, as amended, all applications for new licenses for the operation of commercial broadcast and television stations including TV translator stations, public fixed point-to-point (domestic and international) and public coastal stations that may be filed with this Bureau, shall be supported by authenticated copies of valid Certificates of Public Convenience and Necessity/authority to charge rates from the Board of Communications. If the petitions therefor have been filed with the Board of Communications and are still pending, a certification to that effect from the said Board should be presented to this Bureau.

Likewise, the same requirements shall apply to all applications for the renewal of existing licenses for the above-mentioned radio stations if they are not covered by previously issued Certificates of Public Convenience and Necessity/authority to charge rates.

This Circular shall take effect on October 01, 1974.
