

MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR
NO. 22-A

SUBJECT: Amending Items 1 and 2 of the First Paragraph of Memorandum Circular No. 22.

Effective immediately, items 1 and 2 of the first paragraph of Memorandum Circular No. 22 dated December 13, 1972, is hereby amended to read as follows:

1. The frequencies 143.15 MHz, 143.55 MHz, 143.125 MHz, and 143.325 MHz are hereby assigned to the Armed Forces of the Philippines for the use of all licensed radio stations previously authorized in the 2-meter band or otherwise, operated for PUBLIC INFORMATION, PUBLIC ASSISTANCE and CIVIC ACTION PURPOSES by civic groups, associations and organizations.
2. Owners of radio stations affected by this Circular shall coordinate with the Office of Civil Relations, Armed Forces of the Philippines (OCR, AFP), which shall have immediate supervision and control of the screening and control of all members of civic groups, associations and organizations to be taken in for the above purposes.
