
MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR
NO. 22

SUBJECT: Assigning the Frequency 143.75 mHz for the Use of Currently Licensed Radio Stations Operated for Civic Action Purposes in Lieu of Previously Assigned Frequencies to said Stations which are Withdrawn.

Pursuant to Letter of Instruction No. 13-A of the President of the Philippines dated September 29, 1972 and the provisions of Act No. 3846, as amended, effective immediately, the operation of LICENSED radio stations used for CIVIC ACTION purposes is hereby authorized in accordance with the following guidelines:

1. The frequency 143.75 mHz is hereby assigned to the Armed Forces of the Philippines for the use of all licensed radio stations previously authorized in the 2-meter band or otherwise, operated for civic action purposes by civic groups, associations and organizations. Previously authorized frequencies being used by such stations are hereby withdrawn.
2. Owners of radio stations affected by this Circular shall apply to the Radio Control Office for the modification of their respective station licenses (change of frequency) through the Office of Civil Relations, Armed Forces of the Philippines (OCR, AFP), which shall have immediate supervision and control of the use of the above assigned frequency and hence, the screening and control of all members of civic groups, associations and organizations to be taken in for civic action purposes.
3. The operation of the subject stations is to be handled by holders of appropriate and valid radio operator licenses except those owned and operated by the military.

Memorandum Circular No. 12 dated October 12, 1972 of this Office, as well as any other order, circular, instruction or memorandum or part thereof inconsistent herewith is amended and/or superseded accordingly.
