

MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR
NO. 25-89

SUBJECT: LIFTING OF MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR NO. 22-89

Pursuant to the powers vested upon the National Telecommunications Commission, Memorandum Circular No. 22-89 which included new paragraphs to item C of Memorandum Circular 11-12-85, to wit:

Corollary to the above and in view of the current on-going state of rebellion/terrorism, the following broadcast/telecast guidelines shall be strictly followed:

- A. The airing of rebellious/terrorist propaganda, comments, interviews, information and other similar and/or related materials shall be prohibited.
- B. The airing of government strategic information, including but not limited to government military locations, troop movements, troop numbers, description of government weapons military units, vehicles and such other government tactical operations shall likewise be prohibited.

Are hereby LIFTED for the reason that the state of rebellion/terrorism has been contained.

The Commission however reminds all broadcast and telecast services/system of their duties and responsibilities as public services and/or businesses affected with public interest. Strict adherence to the Constitution, laws, rules and regulations, franchises, permits and licenses and such other authorization issued by the Commission is hereby enjoined.

A special call is hereby made, for utmost cooperation from all broadcast and telecast services/system under the jurisdiction of this Commission, especially at this stage of the social and economic rehabilitation of the country.
