NO. 106-10-2007

SUBJECT : Application Requirements for New Cable Television (CATV) Station

Pursuant to Republic Act 3846, Executive Orders 436 and 205 and other related Circulars/Orders of this Commission and in order for the Commission to act expeditiously on all applications for the issuance of Provisional Authority/Certificate of Authority, to install, operate and maintain CATV System in the country, the Commission hereby prescribes the minimum requirements for the acceptance of Applications for CATV:

1. Application/Petition for Certificate of Authority/Provisional Authority to be filed with the Commission containing the name, mailing address and citizenship of the owner;
2. Television broadcast channels to be carried in compliance with the must carry provisions of NTC Memorandum Circular No. 04-08-88;
3. Applicant's legal, technical and financial capabilities, with an itemized list of investment or property and equipment and its corresponding costing to be used in the operation;
4. Audited Financial Statement, copies of Income Tax Returns for the last three (3) years;
5. SEC Registration with Articles of Incorporation and By-Laws (if corporation) and/or DTI Registration of Business Name (if single proprietorship/partnership);
6. Financial, Economic and Technical Feasibility Studies to support the application;
7. Technical Plans and Diagrams, with schedule of construction and commencement of operation. Two (2) copies of the technical plans should be submitted in blue or white prints drawn in adequate scale or drawing duly signed and sealed by the Registered Electronics and Communications Engineer (ECE) with respect to the electronics equipment in accordance with Republic Act 5734, showing:
 - a) The Service Area, including all barangays to be served and the plan covering the installation of the CATV station;
 - b) Technical specifications or brochure of the amplifier, modulators, combiners and antenna system;
 - c) Cable distribution system (plan) showing the corresponding boundaries of each barangays proposed to be served; and
 - d) Head-end block diagram.
8. Mayor's endorsement to engage in the operation of CATV;
9. Joint Pole Agreement (if none, proof of additional financial capability to erect own poles) with an electric or telephone entity.

Any Circular, Order, Memorandum or parts thereof inconsistent herewith are deemed superseded and/or amended accordingly.
