

**MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR**  
**NO. 10-79**

Effective February 15, 1979, applications that may be filed with this Bureau for licenses/permits indicated hereunder shall be supported by Personal Information Sheets under oath of the applicants, instead of the clearances from the NBI, PC, Police and Fiscal's Office as prescribed in Memorandum Circular No. 75-5 dated March 20, 1975 of this Bureau:

1. Radio station licenses/permits of any class in any service;
2. Radio Operator licenses/permits of any class; and
3. Dealers and Manufactures of radio transmitter and transceiver equipment and communication crystals.

If an applicant is a firm or association, it must submit the Personal Information Sheets of its Officers as follows:

For Sole Proprietorship:

1. Proprietor
2. General Manager (or equivalent)

For Partnership:

1. All partners
2. General Manager (or equivalent)

For Corporation:

1. All members of the Board of Directors
2. President
3. General Manager (or equivalent)

For Association:

1. All members of the Board of Directors/Trustee or equivalent governing body
2. President



It is understood, however, that this Bureau is not precluded from requiring any applicant affected hereby to submit any other needed papers/information or to submit for personal interview when necessary in the interest of national security.

This Circular supersedes TCB Memorandum Circular No. 75-5, date March 20, 1975, and amends any other circular, order, or instruction or part thereof which is inconsistent herewith.
