
SUBJECT: Guidelines for the Purchase, Sale and Manufacture of Crystals

Pursuant to Letter of Instruction No. 13-A of the President of the Philippines dated September 29, 1972, there is hereby prescribed the guidelines for the purchase, sale and manufacture of crystals, as follows:

1. Any person or firm with a valid Radio Station Construction Permit or License intending to purchase a transmitter crystal may do so by securing first a PERMIT TO PURCHASE CRYSTAL from the Radio Control Office or its district offices. The same requirement shall apply to government agencies operating radio stations with valid frequency authorizations. In the case of the Armed Forces of the Philippines, the request for such Permit shall be submitted to the Chief, Communications Electronics Officer, GHQ, AFP, or his duly designated representatives, who are authorized by this Office to issue such Permit.
2. Any authorized dealer or manufacturer of transmitter crystals under this Circular shall not sell any crystal to any person or firm without the latter presenting a Permit to Purchase issued by the Radio Control Office or its district offices.
3. No dealer or manufacturer of transmitter crystals shall engage in such business without first securing a Dealer's or Manufacturer's Permit therefor from the Radio Control Office. A Dealer's or Manufacturer's Permit regarding transmitter crystals may be issued by the Radio Control Office upon application therefor and after payment by the applicant of the required fee of ₱30.00 for Dealer's Permit and ₱60.00 for Manufacturer's Permit, per annum or any fraction thereof. The same Permits are renewable annually upon payment of the fees. Any person or firm who has been granted a Dealer's or Manufacturer's Permit under this Circular shall submit to the Radio Control Office or its district offices within ten (10) days after the end of each month, a regular monthly report of sales as well as the inventory of stocks on hand, which shall include the names and addresses of persons or firms to whom crystals were sold and the corresponding quantities purchased by them.

Failure to comply with this Circular, if a station licensee, shall be dealt with in accordance with the provisions of Act 3846, as amended; and if a dealer or manufacturer of transmitter crystals, the suspension or revocation of his/its Permit.

This Circular shall take effect immediately and it supersedes Memorandum Circular No. 7 dated October 12, 1972.
